- I place group interests above self-interests.

- I accept responsibilities and follow through to complete tasks.
- I make decisions and stand by them.
- I am flexible when change will benefit the group.
- I manage time, energy, and resources well.
- I involve everyone when delegating responsibilities, considering individual abilities, and interests.
