





Have you noticed the new things about ACIC this year? Well if you didn't know, the school has some pretty cool perks, you are just about to find out!

Related Arts

In related arts classes (Music, Library, Computers, Art and P.E.) we are doing a new thing called Related Arts Homerun Rewards and Consequences. The behavior consequences are Strikes. Snack Recipe



Fall Snack Mix Recipe

Ingredients

- 1 Family Size Box of Cheese-Its
- 1 bag of Mini Marshmallows
- 2 bags Candy Pumpkins
- 1 bag Small Twisty Pretzels

Instructions

1. Mix all ingredients together in a large paper sack or bowl. Makes 30-ish 1-cup servings.



The things you will need for this craft are...

- 2 two liter bottles
- A construction paper leaf
- Brown pipe cleaner
- Orange paint
- A wooden dowel

Cut the empty 2 liter bottles using a pair of scissors to the heights of 7 inches and 4 inches. Cut a 2 inch hole an inch below the larger bottle half. Clean and dry to two parts. Paint each with orange paint. Let dry.

Glue the two pieces together and let dry. Make small hole below the 2 inch hole for the dowel stick. Cut 2 small holes in the top of the birdfeeder and place a piece of cord in it with a tied knot to use as a hanger. Use the pipe cleaner to make a brown stem and cut a leaf using the construction paper. Glue the stem and leaf near the hanger.
