DRIVING LABS/SESSIONS:

Each student will be assigned drive sessions. The labs will consist of participating in tire changing and jumper cable labs as well as under the hood locations. Students must have their permits with them in order to drive. Unexcused tardies and missed days can result into losing points.

CLASSROOM PACKET:

Each student will complete a class packet. Packet contains info on various driving topics and issues.

WRITING PROMPTS:

Each Student will complete two writing prompts. The prompts are one page in length. Each student will choose two of the 4 prompts provided.

ARTICLE REVIEW:

Each student will research an article and summarize it in a one page TYPED article review. Article must be related to driving. (Winter driving tips, texting and driving, trip planning). The review must include NAME OF ARTICLE, AUTHOR, NAME OF SOURCE, DATE PUBLISHED.

JOURNAL ENTRIES:

After each driving date, students will complete a journal entry which includes, strengths and weakness, plus any questions or comments students have.

FINAL TEST:

The final will be given on the Final day of class, 50 questions.

INSURANCE DISCOUNT:

Most local insurance companies do give discounts to students who successfully pass the course. A state completion form will be given at the end of the course for students to take to their insurance companies.
