1. Log on to the school webpage at [www.allen.kyschools.us](http://www.allen.kyschools.us).
2. Click on Form/Links on right side of page.
3. Under Links, scroll to the bottom and click on 
4. Students Username-Last name and initial of first name...example John Smith: smithj
5. Students Password-Last 8 digits of student ID# (located at the top of your child's report card).

### Use Test -Taking Strategies

- Get off to a good start.
- Develop a plan.
- Mark the questions you are unsure of in order to return to later.
- Increase your odds on multiple-choice questions by narrowing down the incorrect answers.
- Look for key words in True/False questions.
- Know how to approach open-response questions.
- Check your answers.
- Review all returned tests.

### Parents Can Help Too...How Busy Parents Can Help Their Child Succeed on Tests

- Good attendance-Please make sure your child is present and on time to school each day. Please don't schedule medical appointments or family activities during school hours.*
- Good Health=Good Test Scores-Please make sure your child gets into a routine that includes plenty of rest and a healthy breakfast.*
- Make Reading a Priority-A child who can read well is more likely to succeed in school and do well on standardized tests. Comprehension, Reading Rate, and Vocabulary skills are extremely important.*
