bring it all back on EXAM Day and turn it in for EXTRA CREDIT on EXAM (8-12 POINTS)

3. END of COURSE EXAM = 20% of total grade:

In December/May, each student must take and successfully complete the end-of- course exam according to Kentucky Department of Education requirements to receive a US HISTORY credit towards graduation. This is a multiple choice test measuring your historical knowledge. The EOC Exam is VERY MUCH like the Exams we take every 4 1/2 weeks.

4. Other Points: NO EXTRA CREDIT EXCEPT~

- **Pre-test points.** At the beginning of each unit, you will take a pretest. The number you get RIGHT (divided by 4) on the Pre-test will be added to your 4 ½ weeks exam grade.
- Work from folder turned in on EXAM DAY right before taking exam.

EXPECTATIONS:

WE MOVE QUICKLY through a LOT of Information!!! Come mentally prepared to work.

1. I expect you to come into class each day READY TO LEARN.

2. I expect you to think and act like a *historian* each day. HISTORY is what we DO! ©

3. I expect you to contribute to class discussions in a MATURE MANNER (Raising your hand---No silly or inappropriate comments).

4. I expect you to LISTEN/Pay attention instead of talking during class.

5. I expect you to READ and INTERPRET information A LOT, as well as WRITE/**TAKE NOTES** A LOT (almost DAILY). NOTES will be turned in for a Daily Grade (easy grade!).

6. I expect you to complete ALL assignments with **a distinguished quality** and turn in assignments ON TIME **(late assignments = -10% for each day late).** The only exception is an excused absence. SEE ME THE DAY YOU RETURN FOR MAKE-UP WORK if it isn't on your desk at beginning of class!!

7. I expect you to be ENGAGED in ALL classroom activities, NOT doing work for another class or being occupied with **the forbidden CELL PHONE**: IF YOU LOOK preoccupied with checking your phone or texting, I WILL TAKE IT EVERYTIME!!

8. I expect you to ACTIVELY REVIEW your notes frequently in preparation for the EOC EXAM and before each QUARTER EXAM.

9. You will be assigned a student number for this class. It is to go at the top of ALL WORK next to your name.

10. I expect you to bring a pen or pencil each day! DO NOT ASK ME FOR "SOMTHIN' TO WRITE WITH"!!

11. This classroom is my SECOND HOME. BE AN ADULT: CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF & DO NOT TOUCH ANYTHING THAT DOESN'T BELONG TO YOU!! (ie: Anything that is on display in my room).
